Boston Health Walks offer every week to the community 12 different walking groups in and around Boston. Walks are suitable for beginners through to those wishing to take a longer walk.

All walks are led by trained walk leaders.

Every walk offers various distances a short introduction walk for 10 to 30 minutes and the other a longer distance of up to 3 miles which would take approximately an hour. All new walkers are advised to walk at their own pace and will be supported by the trained walk leaders.

All walks are pushchairs and wheelchair friendly.

Each walking group has 10 different walks that are rotated week to week from the venue listed. After each walk light refreshments are offered and social time is enjoyed by all attending.

Through the walking groups other social activities can be accessed.

In additional to the weekly led walks Boston Borough Council have 10 self led walks which are easily followed using the downloadable walking maps from the download box.

Cost to attend one walk or all twelve weekly walks £1:50p, so you can attend as many as you like and pay only once.
